To our knowledge, we have had no COVID 19 cases on site among Concordia Village Residents or staff. Our efforts are dedicated to keeping it that way. Concordia Village walking paths are now open:

As you know, each winter we close the back paths (north, east and south of the buildings) for safety reasons. Thanks to Spring and our Environment Services team, we are pleased to advise that all walking paths are now open. If you continue to practice social distancing (6 feet from each other), please enjoy a walk in the fresh air!

Resident Exercise Routines:

With all of us feeling a bit confined, thanks to our Recreation Services team we now have exercise routines that may interest all Residents. These are exercises that foster your health and mobility, even if you feel confined by your suite, our hallways and walkways. We intend to update these Routines, for delivery to each suite, on a monthly basis.

Mobile Store – is up and running:

Thanks to our Food Services team, we have started a weekly “Mobile Store” service to deliver pre-paid food essentials to your suite. We are adding more household products to those currently available via the new Mobile Store, once we can be assured that we have a sustainable source of non-food supplies. Alternatively, many grocery stores offer a delivery service. You can order online with retailers such as Superstore, Walmart and Shoppers Drug Mart. You can also call Family Foods at 204-668-2269 or Cantor’s at 204-774-1679. No flower deliveries please – it is not possible to sterilize them without damaging the flowers.
