Dear Concordia Village Residents, Families and Staff:

RE: COVID Update – Thanks to the efforts of everyone involved – Board of Directors, Residents, Leadership Team, Families, Visitors and Staff - we have been COVID Outbreak-Free since mid-March 2020. We continue to take all available proactive and reactive measures to keep it that way.

We are encouraging the Provincial Public Health team to come to the Village and vaccinate all 300+ Residents and 100+ Staff, here at the Village Centre. While we understand that ample vaccine supplies are coming to the Province, we have not received sufficient certainty to plan the actual Assisted Living vaccination week(s) at Concordia Village.

In the meantime, if your loved one is eligible for the COVID vaccine, we would encourage you to enable that. Once we have more credible Provincial Public Health news to share on the vaccine rollout at Concordia Village, we would be publishing that via an updated COVID Memo and our web site.

Current precautions continue:

- Restrict contacts to those in your household, social gatherings are not permitted,
- Screen all incoming Visitors (only Essential Caregivers are permitted entry to the Village),
- Deliver parcels dropped at Village I or II Reception (via our staff) directly to the Resident,
- Provide these internal Deliveries daily from 8 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.,
- Self-isolate for 14 days on return from any overnight stay at a Hospital,
- Ensure that no more than two people at a time use the Elevators,
- Alert by Power of Attorney (POA) or family contact when Resident COVID testing occurs, and
- Advise us of the results of those COVID tests (Positive or Negative).
