Dear Concordia Village Residents, Families and Staff:

RE: COVID Update - Arising from recent changes to Provincial Public Health Orders, precaution changes at Concordia Village, effective today are:

- Fully vaccinated Visitors are now allowed in the building effective Saturday, June 26th (if vaccine card or government issued proof is provided) even if you are not on the Essential List,
- But to keep the number of visitors under control we will only be allowing 2 visitors per day per suite,
- Essential Caregivers can still come and go and do not count towards the 2 visitors per day per suite,
- Church will resume on Sunday, June 27th,
- Exercises will resume on Monday, June 28th,
- Outside Visits, of up to 10 persons plus the Resident, are now permitted,
- Dining, more news in the coming week

We continue with the following precautions:

- Screen all incoming Visitors and Essential Caregivers,
- Deliver parcels dropped at Village I or II Reception (via our staff) directly to the Resident,
- Provide these internal Deliveries daily from 8 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.,
- Ensure that no more than two people at a time use the Elevators,
- Continue to wear masks,
- Alert us of any Positive test results for COVID.
