Dear Concordia Village Residents, Families and Staff:

RE: COVID Update

We remain grateful to all Essential Caregivers, families, staff, and visitors who helped us through the past 18 months of COVID precautions and restrictions.

Arising from the gradual relaxation of Provincial Public Health Orders, precautions lifting at Concordia Village, effective Wednesday, September 1, 2021, are:

- Screening Desks at Village I and Village II entrances are no longer needed and will be removed.
- Capacity limits on visitors are no longer applicable.

Provincial Public Health Recommendations require us to continue the following for a while longer:

- Mask-wearing continues, on entry to (and during transit to suites in) Concordia Village buildings.
- Social distancing of 6 feet (2 metres) continues, while in Concordia Village buildings.
- Please avoid seeking entry to Concordia Village if:
 - you have any symptoms that could be COVID-related, or
 - you have travelled without being fully vaccinated.
