Dear Concordia Village Residents, Families and Staff

RE: COVID 19 Update – Concordia Village

Throughout the pandemic, Concordia Village has closely followed the direction of Public Health when implementing various measures for the safety, protection and well being of our residents.

As many of you are aware, the Province has recently updated its COVID-19 Public Health Orders which will see the removal of all restrictions by mid-March. They are however, suggesting certain measures remain in place as best practices.

In light of the changing restrictions, we have given careful consideration as to how we move forward at Concordia Village.

Accordingly, we are pleased to announce the following changes effective immediately:

- Multi-Purpose rooms will re-open at full capacity without proof of vaccination or social distancing
- There will be no vaccination requirements for residents to attend the dining room or any of our programs
- Residents can now have family join their dining at the guest tables
- Village Centre capacity will be greatly expanded with minimal distancing

In addition, in line with Public Health Orders, residents and visitors will not be required to wear masks effective March 15, 2022, but they are encouraged to do so. Our staff will continue to wear masks for the foreseeable future.

Breakfast will continue as a sit down, served meal but we will reassess possibly opening up the breakfast buffet at a later date.

We thank you for your continued patience over the past two years as we have managed through these very challenging times. While we are optimistic for the future, we are mindful of the unpredictability of this virus and the potential that Public Health Orders could return, though we hope these days are behind us!
