Dear Concordia Village Residents, Staff and Families:

RE: COVID Update - Changes at Concordia Village, effective June 17, 2022 are:

-All Residents are no longer required to wear a mask but are certainly welcome to continue to do so if they wish,

-Visitors are no longer required to wear a mask on entry to and during transit to suites in Concordia Village,

-All staff are no longer required to wear a mask but if they are asked by a resident to put one on while in their suite they must do so,

-Capacity limits have been removed in Elevators,

- We continue to closely monitor the impacts of the virus and will re-implement various measures if we deem appropriate.

We continue with the following precautions:

- DO NOT come to the dining room, or any program if you have ANY cold like symptoms

- Ensure you are sanitizing before entering the dining room and attending programs and when you leave,

- Alert us of any Positive test results for COVID, or if you choose to isolate the 5 days due to symptoms,

- Please reconsider attending a recreation activity if you are a close contact of someone that has tested positive,

-Please avoid seeking entry to Concordia Village if:

-you have any symptoms that could be COVID-related.
